Gaining Recognition of Your Knowledge and Expertise in Case Management

Course Description: Certification in case management demonstrates that the case manager possesses the education, skills, knowledge, and experience required to render appropriate services delivered according to sound principles of practice.

To achieve certification, each applicant must satisfy specific licensure/certification and employment requirements and achieve a passing score on the CCM examination. The examination is based on a body of knowledge that encompasses laws, public regulations, and the delivery of case management services as practiced within the United States.

This Review Course is offered as a step in preparation for the CCM examination. It focuses on the five major domains of essential knowledge typically required to provide case management interventions. This base of knowledge includes:

1. Care delivery and reimbursement methods
2. Psychosocial concepts and support systems
3. Quality and outcomes evaluation and measurements
4. Rehabilitation concepts and strategies
5. Ethical, legal and practice standards

Additionally, this course also offers health care professionals the opportunity to increase their basic case management knowledge.
